Mathematics-

- Numbers 1-5 (In depth understanding)
- 2D shapes
- Sorting and matching numbers
- Counting

Numberblocks will be introduced to support their understanding of numbers.

Phonics-

- Single letter sounds
- Listening for initial sound in words
- Beginning to blend sounds

Reading- Once your child is able to blend, they will be given a book with words in. This will match the sound they are learning in phonics. Please bring them back every day!

Things to remember

We recommend that you purchase a **school book bag** for your child for carrying their work, reading books and reading records. These are available from the office.
